- exchanging of information on the conformity assessment, testing laboratories and EU Directives under which both Parties act as a notified body in their countries
- conformity assessment in recognition of test results in accordance with the laws in force in both Parties order to ensure conditions for the possibility 으
- training of specialists of the Parties to upgrading skills of these professionals; in professional educational systems related



- implementation of a collaborative study;
- comparing of national measurement standards unit quantities;
- using of reference and materials of data on physical constants and properties of substances and on materials defined composition, properties of substances
- recognition of test results according to the agreed term and conditions with the instruments supplied mutually by the Parties. of the approval of type verification and calibration of measurement
